The Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards 2012 **Terms, Conditions and Technical Requirements of Participation**

1. SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS: Schools must provide the name and contact details of a representative (*Head of Department for Film Studies etc*) as chief liaison throughout the Moviemanía Awards process, as well as a copy of their School's logo/emblem/ crest in PDF or JPEG format (at highest resolution possible). Your school representative will be assigned a designated reference number, forwarded upon acceptance of your entry / entries into The Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards 2012. It is a mandatory condition of entry to complete all entry forms, film release, details, information and documentation contained within The Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards satchel supplied and submitted by post to Moviemanía at the address provided (refer to page footer) otherwise entry may be forfeited or refused.

2. ENTRY FEES: Entry is subject to payment of initial registration \$100 per secondary institution or Alumnae entrant due by the **1st April 2012** and an additional \$10 per film submitted, \$100 is charged for 10 entries or more this (Further information is available within the Entry Kit). Should a student wish to enter individually registration is \$50. Non Alumnae Registration fee must be received ASAP,

3. NOMINATIONS: Film credits must be clearly legible and coincide with paperwork, comprehensible & roll at a readable pace; actors are to be listed in order of appearance. A typed cast and crew credit list that match the film's credits will accompany each film submitted (form template provided in Entry Kit for convenience). Be aware the spelling of names provided will be the same as those that appear on your certificates, trophies and awards. Only legitimate errors will be subject to reprint.

4. LICENCING: Moviemanía has the license and rights to broadcast, show and award films containing copyright music material provided the usage of said material is properly and clearly credited in the end titles of your films. You must credit the Title of Song, Artist / group performing Song, Recording label / Distribution Company and year of song / album release.

5. ALUMNAE (GRADUATE) CATEGORY: Students must be current high school students in 2012 ~ Year 12 students from 2011 are eligible to enter the 2012 Awards & submit completed films to compete within an individual sub division (YEAR 12 ALUMNAE AWARD), provided the final films; are completed in 2010 with corresponding paperwork (*the Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards ALUMNAE ENTRY KIT*) and any correspondence are given directly to Moviemanía. Only an individual name / entrant can be nominated in chosen categories. Alumnae entrants will not be evaluated against the main body of entrants but will be compared within their own category, duly noted and rewarded for their efforts inclusively at both the Educational Screening (LOCATION) TBA, as well as Genre awards, People's Choice and an overall award for the winner of the Alumnae division at the Gala Award Night. All paperwork, film submissions and payment of entry fees are due by **August 2012**.

6. EDUCATIONAL SCREENINGS: Films must be an average of 8 minutes in duration, including credits. Due to popularity and an overwhelming number of submissions, films exceeding 8 minutes in duration may restrict the overall number of films shown for the Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards Educational Screening - location TBA or other (which you must specify and identify with your submission details). The Educational Screenings are also the only opportunity to vote, (via paper ballot), for films to qualify for the People's Choice Awards.

7. GENRE AWARDS: Short films can be any genre from the following categories: Comedy, Documentary, Mockumentary, Drama / Narrative, Horror, Thriller, Film Noir / Detective, Action, Avante Garde / Abstract / Experimental, Animation, Musical, Western, Romance, Science Fiction, Commercial, Classic / Period / Epic/ War and all films with an elected genre automatically qualify for an additional award category especially for the subdivision of aforementioned Genres.

8. SCRIPT WRITING CATEGORY: Students must compose and submit a script/s and or storyboard/s as well as writer/s nomination/s by **August 2012** to be eligible for the scriptwriting category.

9. POSTER CATEGORY: In order to qualify for the Best Poster Category an individual or school group must create a Publicity Poster for the film/s submitted. The mandatory, maximum dimensions of the poster should be no more than 900mm in height x 600mm in width and must be rolled (do not fold – *the best poster will be professionally framed and the folds look awful!*) and sent in a mailing tube to Moviemanía by **August 2012**.

10. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS: Acceptable format for final film delivery is an **DVD file** (in an unlocked format) saved to **DVD disc**. **Each film must be on a separate DVD, not in groups**. Do not submit the only master copy of your film/s as Moviemanía is not liable for any loss or damage to materials sent to or from, and sent or received by Moviemanía. Ensure all discs, covers, sleeves and jackets are at least clearly labeled with the name of you're: School, Film title and alphabetical letter that matches with your Submission / Entry Kit documents. Moviemanía must receive your films and all remaining Entry Kit documentation no later than **August 2012**. **Please ensure that all students' names are correctly spelt on all paperwork**.

11. EXEMPTIONS: Films will not be eligible if they contain: Explicit nudity, sex or graphic sexual references. Racism or discrimination is considered as an insight too, or graphic depiction of, hatred, cruelty and or violence toward another nationality, culture, gender, person or animal. Themes that trivialize glamorize or appear to condone drug use and or abuse will not be accepted.

-Suicide is an extremely sensitive and topical issue for teens, however due to potential offense and trauma associated with the nature of the theme if film makers feel the necessity to explore it, they are urged to use the utmost integrity and tact. Exploitation and graphic representation of suicide will eliminate films from the Educational Screening. Films may still be considered for judging and feed back. Negotiation, approval, special circumstances or unique treatment of such themes must be discussed with Anita Smith of Moviemanía **prior** to script submission. It is the right, responsibility and discretion of Moviemanía management to remove or exclude films from any stage/s of the Awards process (in particular reference to the Educational Screening).

12. AWARD COLLECTION: **Your film materials, awards and certification can be collected during or at the conclusion of the Moviemanía High School Short Film Awards, Gala Night. Postage or delivery of any abovementioned items is the responsibility of the winner (school / student) to subsidize prior to forwarding of said items.**

The trophy for this category will go to the school. Full detailed credits must be included in legible writing and in an appropriate speed. The winner of the Feature Length Film category will be announced prior to the Gala night and will be shown at the cinema viewing. The one submitted film per school must be a 2012 creation and may not be considered by any means an Alumnae Film (made in 2011 or by now graduated film students).

Entry fee for the Feature Length Category is \$20 per film.
